Magnusson Architecture and Planning (MAP) promoted **Jeffrey Drucker** to director of health care architecture. Drucker's health care projects include New York University's downtown hospital expansion and renovations; the two-story ER/maternity addition to Maimonides Medical Center in Brooklyn; Norwalk Hospital's diagnostic imaging department; master planning of the expansion/renovation of Northern Dutchess Hospital; construction of the hyperbaric chambers and emergency department at Cabrini Medical Center in Manhattan; and several projects at Staten Island University Hospital.

In 2002, the Society of American Registered Architects presented Drucker and his design team with the prestigious SARA Award, for exemplary work on Staten Island University Hospital's six-story, 103,000-square-foot Critical Care Tower, containing a state-of-the-art heart institute, oncology and image-guided surgery suite. At MAP, Drucker is currently handling several assignments for Bronx Lebanon Hospital.
