## **Magnusson Architecture and Planning P.C. Relaunches on Union Square and Adds New Principal**

**Four years after merging with a large design firm, Magnusson Architecture and Planning (MAP), a design and planning practice, has been reestablished**

Mr. Magnusson, who formed MAP in 1986, and Mr. Stand, who joined in 1992, departed Larsen Shein Ginsberg + Magnusson Architects to relaunch MAP, a leading community development, planning and design firm noted for its endeavors involving urban housing, especially in Melrose Commons, an innovative urban renewal area in the South Bronx.

To further strengthen MAP's scope, the firm has added a third principal, Joseph Lengeling, AIA, who brings more than 30 years of design experience to the firm.

While with noted New York City firms Fox & Fowle Architects, Cooper, Robertson & Partners, Mitchell/Giurgola Architects, and his own practice, Mr. Lengeling was the project designer of Manhattan's Stuyvesant High School, the Berkeley Carroll School's Science Suite in Brooklyn and the Genesis Apartments at Union Square. He also provided master planning for Duke University's expansion to its Medical Center, and the HELP USA site for Ward's Island.

MAP, whose new offices are at 853 Broadway on Union Square, specializes in designing educational facilities, affordable and special needs housing, and master planning and site development.

The firm's current projects include: three new housing developments in the Melrose Commons section of the Bronx, new mixed-use housing developments in Brooklyn and Manhattan, and a senior housing complex in Middleton, N.Y.
